


Family Tree Information Gap

Teacher's Directions:

1. Make groups of four students.
2. Give each student a card with different information about the Rodriguez family. The cards are "secret information" so students should not show each other their cards. Students must ask questions about the Rodriguez family to get the needed information.
3. Students ask each other about how the members are related (Who is Julio's mother?) and what jobs the parents, aunts and uncles do.
4. Which group will finish first? For a large class, this lesson can be a contest to see which group finishes first.



Clue Cards

1. The grandfather of Carlos is called Esteban.
2. Miyuki's husband is a bus driver.
3. Katrina has two sons.
4. Evelyn is David's cousin.
5. **The doctor is called Julio.**
6. Emilio and David are brothers.

1. Evelyn's mother is a nurse.
2. The bus driver's son's name is Toru.
3. Maria's daughter-in-law is a nurse.
4. Julio and Romano are brothers.
5. Carlos is Alice's son.
6. Katrina has two brothers.

1. Emilio's parents are both teachers.
2. Maria is a grandmother.
3. Alice is Julio's wife.
4. Bill is Maria's son-in-law.
5. The nurse is married to Romano.
6. Carlos is an only child.

1. Katrina is Toru's aunt.
2. One of Bill's nephews is called Toru.
3. Romano married Miyuki.
4. The doctor's wife is a hairdresser.
5. Carlos and Toru are cousins.
6. Esteban has two sons and a daughter.
